Headteacher's Message

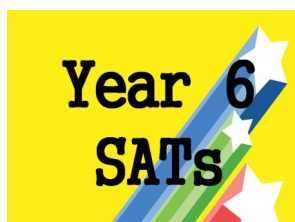

"This week we have been exploring the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We have given the Big Bad Wolf disguises to wear on our funky fingers table and dressed up as characters from the story. We have loved howling like a wolf and prowling through the woods!"

Year 1

"This week we have loved diving into the story of 'The Tale of Peter Rabbit and acting out the story—focusing on our oracy skills when acting. In Science, we learnt all about our senses which will help us with our descriptive writing next week"

Year 2

"We have worked hard this week creating some group diamante poems—ready to write our own. In Maths we have been measuring different objects using cm and m. We have also been working hard on our handwriting and practicing our dance for the festival next week"

Year 3
