Headteacher's Message

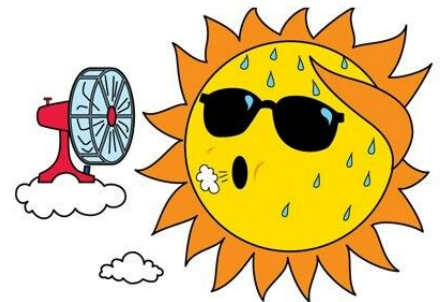
Thank you to all of our parents and friends of the school who came and attended Special Person's lunch throughout the week. It is always so great to see this event so well supported and the children love having you visit!
